Two months after graduating university, Binsky moved to South Korea to become an English teacher. During his 18 months living in Korea, he started his first travel blog – "The Hungry Partier" – where he could document his travel and nightlife experiences around the world. Determined to grow a global audience from day one, Binsky spent 50+ hours per week writing blog posts, networking with other bloggers, and growing his social media channels from the ground up.

After 3 years of hard work and patience, Binsky grew "The Hungry Partier" to 150K+ monthly readers and 100K+ social media followers. He rebranded himself to his name, Drew Binsky, which is how he is known on all social media channels.

In 2015, Binsky left Korea to travel the world full-time with the dream to visit every country in the world. Over the last few years, he has developed a love for visiting countries that are perceived as dangerous — Afghanistan, Venezuela, Iraq, Syria, Pakistan, Libya, and Iran.
